So i want to introduce my latest design which for competition in Taiwan. About that project "wonderland": in 2015 December, i participated competition in Taipei by that project. Object given from competition organizers and competitors should design indoor area according to function as kid room playing area. More than 530 project participated and finally my design could won to get 1st prize after oral presentation between 19 final competitors in final stage.

I wanna emphasize one more architecture project - "Mongolian style" hotel. it was my 1st architecture project which designed in 2011. it was pretty long time ago and now i only have video on Youtube. link is https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=OxGD506uznQ

That is 5 star hotel and 36 floors which shows Mongolian tradition style mix with modern style architecture and luxury hotel will be most suitable place for tourists. Building shape design idea source from Mongolian traditional teapot.

Graduate school

I understood that design is not only solution. The solution is combining design, function, technical, research and analysis to prove how it solving the problems. I learned and figured out many new thing from my helpful teachers and students in engineering department. My research topic is "Double skin facade for existing building in Mongolia /modeling and simulation in virtual environment/". It is about determining problems of proposed building such as poor designed facade, climate extreme how influence to users comfort during winter and summer season, so on... Result will be shows how to solving that problems using double skin facade in virtual environment which means using engineering method and research combining designing solution too.

My topic is Double skin facade modeling and simulation virtual analysis for old building. Double skin facade means - old /poor designed/ building covered by new glass skin with ventilation. There is 30-90sm space between that old and new skin facade and some air circulate in that space. /we call it cavity/

That glass skin material should be environmental friendly and accept sunshine to collect warm air in the cavity. The main function is - hot airflow from out into cavity to circulated getting colder or cold air getting warmer in the cavity using double skin facade system to control indoor climate to bring more thermal comfort into indoor area. I am testing that system on old building which is existing in Ulaanbaatar city, Mongolia. Because it is high mountain located country and extremely different climate impacts in winter in summer. Climate extreme brings many problems to construction field such as lose heating... During winter period start October until April and average temperature around -30 degree.

During that period we spend a lot energy to keep warm inside. But still heat losing problem existing and energy cost increasing. So i am determining all physical analysis of that proposed building such as solar, sun path, airflow analysis based on that location using 3D model and virtual testing. Then design double skin facade for proposed building to get result that how it works and how heat losing could decrease and save energy. Thesis purpose is sustainable renovation of old building.

My proposed building for kindergarten and attending more than 300 children each year from September till June. During that cold period kids easy to get sick in the kindergarten. I think it is important topic that we have to pay attention and bring more comfort and healthy environment for them.

Also that poor designed building facade would change to beautiful modern building. It would contribute to urban development to make beautiful environment

Hometown

I am from Mongolia, and it's located in the center of Asia. As it's located in the middle we have both eastern and western culture and our people's behavior is unique that we have both Asian and Western type of personality. Historically Mongolia is a nomadic country so that still till day we have nomads all over the country. You would be able to wild nature that's hasn't been touched by humans. For example, Gobi desert is a famous spot for its beauty and uniqueness. Although we still try to keep our tradition, most of the population adjusted to modernization and most of the people of the country live in the cities. My hometown, also the capital city Ulaanbaatar city is most populated city in the country. The lives in the city is not much different from Taiwan's city lifestyle. For our holiday we go to countryside to enjoy the wild nature and relax.  But Mongolians everyday cook at home. Very seldom we skip that cooking time to eat out :) specially in holiday :)
- Most foods taste sweet for me in Taiwan, even meat.:p And drinks, tea. But Mongolians food, tea, everything taste is salty. We never mix sugar with food or tea. Only candy or cookies are sweet there:)
- Climate very different. Taiwan is so humid and hot climate country. Mongolia is so dry and windy. Summer period only for 3 months and +20 to +30 degree. but winter start from November till March /around -20 to -30 degree/.
